Derby City CrossFit is collecting used athletic sneakers through an initiative called "**Dunk Your Kicks**", which benefits The Max Cure Foundation, dedicated to raising funds for **pediatric cancer research** and providing **financial assistance** to low-income and/or military families who have a child with cancer.

Through Dunk Your Kicks, MCF collects used sneakers at gyms across the country. In turn, they work with an international footwear recycler, who gives MCF up to \$1.00 for every pair of shoes donated. Rethink Nation goes on to sell the shoes at an affordable price in developing nations, where access to proper footwear is often limited.
